

Solomons Visitor Center to Relocate to the Calvert Marine Museum

Prince Frederick, MD – October 9, 2019 – The Calvert County Department of Economic Development announces the Solomons Visitor Center will relocate from its current location at the base of Thomas Johnson Bridge to the lobby of the Calvert Marine Museum. The museum is located at 14200 Solomons Island Road South in Solomons.

The center will be closed Saturday, Oct. 12 and Sunday, Oct. 13, and will reopen at the Calvert Marine Museum Saturday, Oct. 19. The visitor center will operate on a seasonal schedule Saturdays, 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Sundays, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. The center will be closed Monday through Friday. The fall and winter hours will remain in effect until April 30, 2020.
