

12 Ducklings Stuck in Storm Drain are Saved by Wildlife Heroes

Pasadena, MD - On Tuesday, April 14, 2020, Maryland Natural Resources Police Officer Miller, assisted by the Anne Arundel County Fire Department Station 23, rescued 12 ducklings that were stuck in a storm drain.
