

## SMCSO Seeking Identities for Theft Suspects at T-Mobile Store

**CALIFORNIA, Md.** - The St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office is seeking the identities of the persons shown in a theft investigation. On Wednesday, Nov. 18, 2020 at 6:50 pm, Suspect 1 entered the California T-Mobile store and asked about updating his phone. Suspect 2 entered when the store employee went to the back to retrieve a phone for the first suspect to look at. Both suspects then used wire cutters to remove several cellphones from their displays and fled the store without paying for them.

Four Samsung Galaxy Note 20 phones and four Apple iPhone 12s were stolen.
