

## UPDATE: Police Conducting Death Investigation in Lexington Park

### UPDATE Jan. 3, 2011

On December 15, 2010 officers responded to a report of an individual deceased in a wooded area along Great Mills Road in Lexington Park. The deceased was identified as Gregory Glenn Gray, 50 of no fixed address. Gray's body was sent to the Office of the Maryland State Medical Examiner for an autopsy. The Medical Examiner's Office has ruled the cause of death to be hypothermia.

**UPDATE Dec. 15 OFFICIAL PRESS RELEASE:** On Dec. 15 at 8:17 a.m. police units responded to a wooded area off of Great Mills Road in Lexington Park, for a report of a person lying in the woods unresponsive.

Upon arrival units discovered Gregory Glenn Gray, age 50, of no fixed address deceased. Gray was transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner in Baltimore, Maryland where an autopsy will be performed to determine the cause and manner of death. Authorities in St. Mary's County are conducting a death investigation in Lexington Park.

St. Mary's County Police along with Maryland State Police responded to the 21600 block of Great Mills Road across from the Lexington Park Exxon around 8:15 a.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 15 for report of a body found.

Investigation revealed the body of a male, unknown age and of unknown origin was discovered near a construction area. No foul play is suspected at this point in time.

According to people on the street, the man is believed to have been drinking, passed out and may have died as a result of the extreme cold.
