Annapolis, MD - State Senator Steve Waugh [R - District 29] presents a report from Annapolis, where the Maryland General Assembly is currently in session.

Senate Bill 509, Veteran Resource Centers - This bill requires each community college to employ at least one full-time veterans advisor to provide enrollment and advising services to students who are veterans and to establish a veterans resource center on the community college campus. Veterans need a comprehensive center that consolidates timely, information essential to making effective transitions, access to retraining, and focused reintegration resources.
