LEONARDTOWN, Md. – St. Mary's County Public Schools is providing supports for students and staff in the process of recovery and transition to return to school.

Great Mills High School will reopen for staff on Monday, April 2, 2018, and all students will return on Tuesday, April 3, 2018. This will allow for staff to prepare for students and ensure proper supports are available. When students return, additional counselors and mental health providers will be on site to assist students.

During the week of March 26 - 30, 2018, continued support is available for students, staff, and families of Great Mills High School.
