Glen Burnie, Md. - The Maryland Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Administration (MDOT MVA) will close all branch offices and VEIP (vehicle emissions inspection program) stations on Monday, February 18, 2019 in observance of the Presidents' Day holiday.

MDOT MVA self-service VEIP kiosks, online services and 24-hour kiosks are available to complete many customer transactions.

All MDOT MVA offices and VEIP stations will reopen on Tuesday, February 19.

- Driver's License Renewals
- Substitute Stickers.

MDOT MVA also reminds customers that extended service hours are available on Thursdays and Saturdays.
