### Assault on Police Officer / Linthicum

On June 28, 2019, at approximately 1640 p.m., officers responded to the intersection of Maple Road E. and Orchard Road in Linthicum to check on the welfare of a male who was slumped over the wheel of a red Chevrolet S10 pickup truck in the middle of the intersection. Upon arrival, officers observed the male asleep at the wheel.

Officers approached the vehicle and knocked on the window of the locked vehicle in an attempt to wake the male. As the officers were standing near the front of the vehicle, the male regained consciousness, made direct eye contact with the officers, and accelerated toward them.

One of the officers had to push off of the vehicle to avoid being injured. The suspect then swerved in an apparent attempt to strike the other officer and then fled the area. Officers located the located the vehicle and apprehended the suspect. No injuries or property damage were reported as a result of this incident.
